We also run into issue with a swampy parking lot after heavy rains and it's no fun riding in the rain for 6 or 12-hours and then have to get your vehicle unstuck from a muddy field. We are keeping a close eye on the weather and if we think we have to postpone the event, we will make the call on Thursday afternoon and let you all know via email. We have some rain dates in the works and will provide additional information on Thursday if we have to postpone the event (including deferral and refund options). You can set up a 10x10 tent (or smaller) in the field adjacent to [Downriver Canoe Company](#)/start and finish area (follow directions once on site) for some rest, recovery, and camaraderie in your personal pit stop area. If you are on a team, you can only have one team member on course at once. The rider can do as many laps as he or she would like before switching out with a teammate. Remember that the course is open to the public, so please follow the rules of the trail, including yielding to horses. Be sure to stick around for the 6-hour and 12-hour awards.
