It's almost Shenanduro Saturday, and we are super excited that you will be joining us for this 5th edition! The weather looks much better for the Shenanduro. We're also glad to be part of the [Virginia State Park Adventure Series](#), and we wish all those competitors happy point earning.

As of now, our refund and transfer policy is back to our [standard policy](#). All refunds and transfers related to the rain delay have been completed. The only exception of this is for the 12-hour. See below.

There have been quite a few shuffles after the rain delay, so please double check your teams.** If you need to make any changes, please email mark@adventureenablers.com.

You can set up a 10x10 tent (or smaller) in the field adjacent to [Downriver Canoe Company](#)/start and finish area (follow directions once on site) for some rest, recovery, and camaraderie in your personal pit stop area. If you are on a team, you can only have one team member on course at once. The rider can do as many laps as he or she would like before switching out with a teammate. Remember that the course is open to the public, so please follow the rules of the trail, including yielding to horses. Be sure to stick around for the awards.

There is no onsite camping on Friday or Saturday night.

12-hour consolidation

Unfortunately, with the number of deferrals and cancellation caused by the rain delay, as of today we only have 16 riders in the 12-hour event. Because of the small number of riders remaining in this category, we have decided to cancel the 12-hour and move the entries to the 6-hour. If you had signed up for the 12-hour, we will refund a portion of your entry fee to make it commiserate with the 6-hour rate. If you decide that you do not want to do the 6-hour, we will provide a full refund. If you want to change your team makeup, please let me know and I will make that adjustment. We will be increasing the depth of awards in the 6-hour event.
