USE CAUTION WHILE IN THE QUARRY AND KEEP YOUR HELMETS ON AND SECURED

Should be obvious, but the map is by no means drawn to scale or entirely accurate; have fun exploring!

- Q1 Corner of ledge
- Q2 Nook, two-inch borehole, climb up
- Q3 Corner of ledge, right of robot
- Q4 Ledge/platform, boreholes
- Q5 Behind stone slab/table, climb up
- Q6 Ledge: old hooks: use caution when climbing up
- Q7 Nook/alcove, quarry wall
- Q8 North Entrance: find your way UP: vista over Q6
